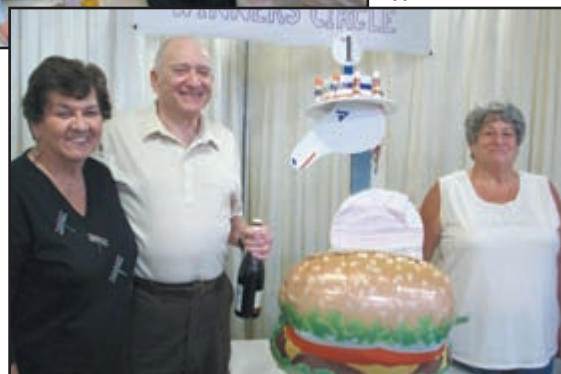
## Temple Emeth Shalom's Temple Derby
